Increase of 6.8% to date in tonnage from 2017 to 2018		Approximately the same

2019 cost per tonne will be \$87.40 which is an increase of 4.8% over 2018.

The ever-increasing costs per tonne and the amount of garbage collected, may mean that property tax rates could increase. Council may go back to the original system of picking up recycle every second week. When recycles gets put in the trash, it costs an extra \$54.00 per tonne. If we all played a larger roll in recycling, composting and green cone digesting, we could cut the costs of disposal.

Other ways to reduce waste tonnage are:

Electronics can be dropped off at Lions Club (Dumpster at back of building) and / or Porter's Bottle Exchange.

Metal items such as car rims, washers, etc. can be dropped off at Lions Club Dumpster.

Returnable bottles can be dropped off at Spectrum Spray or Porter's Bottle Exchange.

Paint and batteries can be dropped off at Bett's Home Hardware.

Used clothes, toys, dishes, etc. can be dropped off at Central NB Self Help.

NOTE: Please do not deface Blue Bins. They are to be used for Recycles only. If you have defaced the Blue Bin, please clean it up to original state. Please help Our Community **save money** by using your bin for recycles.

The 3rd Annual Breast Cancer Wellness Event was another wonderful success.




I miss you so much, maybe its your clothes I often wear that keeps reminding me of how great you were.


Thanks be to God through the Holy Spirit, He made this happen.
