Some areas that were selected and planted in 1985

Large tall trees now

Here are pictures of Red Pine Trees. I (Bryce) had planted in 1985. Planted over 1000 plants at this time. I (Bryce) was a Forestry Management Registered member.

At this time the marketing Board would pay 80% of cost preparing the plantation. The Landowner would buy the small plants at a special price plus 20% of cost to the Contractor. However sometimes the Contractor would not charge the full 20% to the Landowner if the land was easy to get ready for planting.

The gentleman from Taymouth that was taken in Airplane Crash, was very much involved with this work. Along with Mr Palmer, Manager of the York Marketing Board.

I (Bryce) am still involved in Planting Trees now in 2019. See Picture of Blue Spruce



Green container for most garbage scraps. After 5 years only about 50% up to height inside. Properly installed with crushed rock at bottom.

Also inquiring about Solar Sun Panels for our home. I feel these things are much more effective, than paying Extra fuel tax that has been proposed by the now Federal Gov't.
