## MAYOR, COUNCIL AND STAFF OF THE RURAL COMMUNITY OF UPPER MIRAMICHI

After watching events unfold over the last month and the unseen circumstances evolve, we ask people to be: informed, patient, calm and respectful. As all residents are aware our Rural Community, Province, Country and our World has been drastically altered. Not since the Spanish Flu of 1918 have peoples lives been this affected. We are in unchartered territory, but we can all play a major part in our Rural Community by adhering to the Provincial State of Emergency declared last week. Our main priorities are:

- The health, safety and well being of residents
- Maintaining the Rural Community's essential services

Although our Community has yet to declare a state of emergency, our EMO committee has been operating at Level one of active monitoring while working closely with the Chief Medical Officer of New Brunswick, the Emergency Measures Organization, and our Regional Medical Officer through daily emails and weekly conference calls.

#### **STAY INFORMED**

- If you are showing symptoms such as fever, coughing and difficulty breathing, complete
  the COVID 19 Self-Assessment on line at GNB.ca/coronavirus website, and or contact
  Tele Care by dialing 811.
- Access reliable COVID 19(coronavirus) information on GNB.ca/coronavirus website.
- CBC News provides live updates. The live update for New Brunswick takes place daily around 2:30 pm.
- We understand the economic strain which may be placed upon families and businesses.
   Please make use of economic measures which have been introduced by the Provincial and Federal Government
- If you test positive for COVID 19, you must self isolate for 14 days. People in contact with you must self isolate. Failure to do so can result in fines and jailtime. #### **FOLLOW TRAVEL PROTOCOLS**

- All residents returning home from outside of Canada <u>MUST SELF-ISOLATE FOR 14 DAYS</u> in an effort to slow down the spread of the virus.
- All residents who have come in contact with a traveller from outside Canada must isolate themselves.
- All interprovincial, territorial and international travellers <u>MUST SELF-ISOLATE FOR 14</u>
   DAYS.

#### FOLLOW HYGIENE AND SOCIAL DISTANCING PROTOCOLS

- Stay home when possible PLEASE!
- Maintain at least 2 meters distance between you and others.
- The province has restricted gatherings to 10 or less in an area at one time. This includes businesses, retailers and residences.
- If you feel ill in any way, <u>STAY HOME!</u> And self isolate.
- Hand sanitize regularly! Hand wash using the 6-step approach for a minimum of 20 seconds.
- Practice safe etiquette when you cough or sneeze by covering your nose and mouth with your elbow.
- Wipe down and disinfect common surfaces in your home, business and vehicle on a regular basis.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth while out or with unwashed hands.
- Do not share consumable items with others.

#### LOOK AFTER YOURSELF AND BE AWARE OF OTHERS

- Rest often and eat well. Get as much physical activity as possible
- Watch for health problems and signs of stress. Get Help or give help if asked or if needed.
- Don't binge buy items leaving others without.
- Call and check in with vulnerable family, friends and neighbors.

- POLICING- Operating the same as always but people are unable to get background checks etc..
- FIRE DEPARTMENT- operating same as always.

- DOAKTOWN PHARMASAVE-operating same as always
- HOME HARDWARE-operating same as always

#### **Recycling Program Temporarily Suspended:**

In order to reduce the risk of spreading the Covid-19 to sorting facility staff, the processing facility that the Greater Miramichi recyclables are sent to has temporarily closed.

Effective March 30<sup>th</sup>, 2020 the Residential Curbside Recycling program will be temporarily suspended until further notice. Garbage will be collected on a weekly basis during this time. Residents are encouraged to stockpile their recyclables as long as possible to be recycled at a later date.

#### Office Closure:

The offices of the GMRSC are closed to the public as we do our part to help limit the spread of the Covid - 19 virus. However, services are continuing to be provided. The GMRSC has the ability to provide services to the public by using remote computer server technology. All Commission staff are able to work remotely from home. Staff will be able to talk to clients via cell phones, via email and text. Additionally, staff will have ability to access files, process applications such as building permits, subdivision plans, variances and document approvals. As well, staff are available to provide direction and advice to clients relating to a variety of construction and development projects. Arrangements can be made to submit building or subdivision plans for review (either digitally or dropped off at the office at 1773 Water Street).




