Building Inspector – Village of Doaktown

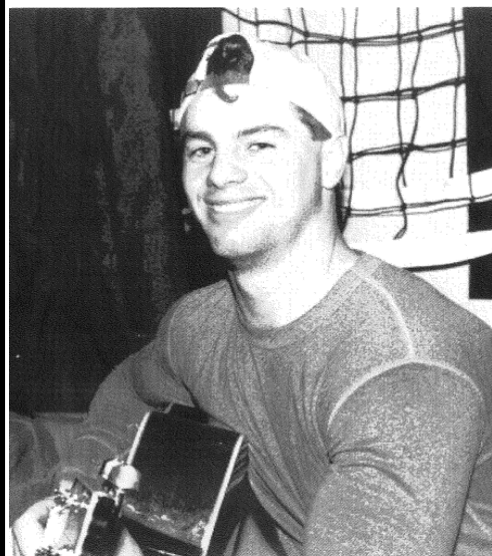
June 9th to October 6th, 2020
